



Offshore S-Cape Emergency Evacuation System

Course overview

The course designed to familiarise candidates with the S-Cape Emergency Evacuation system. Delegates will learn where it is located offshore and how to use it, identify the components and perform a descent. By the end of the course candidates will prove their competency in its content of the kit, how to wear it, identify the right anchor point and operating it in a safe manner displaying full control.

Course structure

S-Cape DVD, awareness of use and practical instruction

Course content

Introduction to the S-Cape emergency Evaluation system. Where and when to use it. Practical use, operation of the descender and locking procedure. Use of handrail stop and painterline stop. All delegates will be required to use the S-Cape system and perform a descent.
